

# Death Claims L. D. S. Worker

FARMINGTON — Mrs. Ardella Rosetta Long Walsh, 86, of Farmington, died in an Ogden hospital



Sunday at 6:30 a. m. Death was due to natural causes.

Funeral services will be conducted at the Farmington L. D. S. ward chapel Wednesday at 1 p. m. Interment will be in Farmington city cemetery.

Mrs. Walsh Walsh was born in Loestaff, England, January 2, 1853. She came to Utah in 1869, living in Salt Lake City until 1892, when she moved to Farmington. She resided in the latter community for the remainder of her life.

July 10, 1879, she married the late John R. Walsh in the Salt Lake City Endowment house. Throughout her life she was very active in L. D. S. church work, being an organizer of the Farmington Retrenchment society, an officer of the Y. L. M. I. A. and a prominent member of the Relief society.

Surviving are a son, Bishop John R. Walsh, and a daughter, Miss Edith Walsh, both of Farmington.
