Dear Strong Family Members:

As requested, I have performed additional searches on the ancestry of Anthoni Hauer (1738). I am enclosing pedigree charts and family group records reflecting the results of my searches. Also enclosed are Temple Ready and Update Disks.

At this point I would like to comment on each of the enclosed family group records and make recommendations for continued research.

Hans Christoph Hauer & Anna Catharina Körber

Hans Christoph and Anna Catharina are the parents of your ancestor Christoph Hauer who immigrated to America, settling in Pennsylvania.

Hans was born 22 Oct 1674 at Blankenloch, Baden, Germany and was christened there 25 Oct 1674, the son of Christoph Hauer and Anna Catharina. He married Anna Catharina Körber 10 Jun 1700 at Blankenloch. She was born in 1676 at Rußheim, Baden, Germany, the daughter of Bernhard Körber. The Rußheim church records do not begin until 1692, so I was not able to obtain her birth/christening record.

Hans and Anna are the parents of 2 children, both of whom were born at Blankenloch. Except for the death of the daughter Margretha, this family group record is complete. So far I have not found her death at Blankenloch. Her husband, Georg Niderhalt, was residing at Vorra, Bayern, Germany when they married in 1721. Perhaps her death occurred at Vorra.

Hans Christoph Hauer & Anna Maria Stirner

After the death of his first wife, Anna Catharina Körber 16 Feb 1703, Hans married Anna

Maria Stirner 18 Nov 1704 at Blankenloch. Based on her age at death, Anna Maria Stirner was born in 1678 at Blankenloch, the daughter of Peter Stirner. Pages are missing in the church records of Blankenloch during the period she would have been born, so I could not obtain her birth/christening record.

Hans and Anna Maria are the parents of 5 children; all born at Blankenloch. According to German records, their daughter Anna Catharina died in the United States. I have not made searches to see if I can locate her in American records. Their son Antonius also immigrated to the United States, but I haven't made searches to locate his death.

Christoph Hauer & Anna Catharina

Christoph was born about 1622 (based on his age at death) in Blankenloch. He married Anna Catharina about 1657, probably in Blankenloch. I have approximated her birth as 1630. The church records of Blankenloch do not begin until 1672, so I have not been able to locate further information on Christoph and Anna Catharina.

Christoph and Anna Catharina are the parents of 4 children; all born at Blankenloch. Since the church records of Blankenloch do not begin until 1672 and there are pages missing in the registers, I have not been able to obtain birth/christening dates for children 1, 2, and 4.

This family group is now complete.

Bernhard Körber & Mrs.

This family originated in Rußheim, Baden, Germany. However, since the records do not begin until 1696, I did not make a search in those records for this family. The daughter Anna Catharina married Hans Christoph Hauer 10 Jun 1700 at Blankenloch. The marriage record states that she is the daughter of deceased Bernhard Körber of Rußheim.

It may be possible to identify additional children of Bernhard by searching the marriage records of Rußheim. The marriage records usually identify the fathers of the bridal couple.

Anthoni Müller & Anna Margaretha Gamer

Anthoni was born 4 Dec 1686 at Blankenloch, Baden, Germany and was christened there 5 Dec 1686, the son of Peter Samuel Müller and Margarethe Nagel. He married Anna Margaretha Gamer 11 Jan 1707 at Blankenloch. She was born 7 Nov 1686 at Staffort, Baden, Germany and was christened there 9 Nov 1686, the daughter of Hannß Martin Gamer and Anna Barbara.

Anthoni and Anna Margaretha are the parents of 9 children; all born at Blankenloch. This family group record is complete except for locating the death of the eldest child, Anna Margretha Barbara, who married Hanß Georg Ernst.

Anthoni Müller & Anna Maria Haisch

After the death of his first wife, Anna Margaretha Gamer, Anthoni Müller married Anna Maria Haisch 16 Sep 1744 at Blankenloch. She was christened 2 Feb 1710 at Blankenloch, the daughter of Hannß Georg Haisch and Margaretha Barbara Cammerer.

Anthoni and Anna Maria are the parents of one son, Johann Georg, christened 28 Nov 1746 at Blankenloch.

This family group record is complete.

Peter Samuel Müller & Margaretha Nagel

Peter Samuel Müller was born in March 1652 at Büchig, Baden, Germany, the son of Georg Müller and Barbara. Peter married Margaretha 26 Nov 1672 at Staffort, Baden, Germany. She is the daughter of Antonius Nagel and Anna Cathrine.

Peter and Margaretha are the parents of 4 children; all born at Blankenloch. Because there are gaps in the church records of Blankenloch I have not been able to find birth/christening records for the 2 elder children.

This family group record is complete.

Georg Müller & Barbara

I have approximated Georg's birth as 1626 and Barbara's birth as 1628. They were married about 1650. So far I have only identified 1 child of this couple, your ancestor Peter Samuel born Mar 1652 at Büchig.

Additional searches in the church records of Blankenloch may yield information on additional children.

Antonius Nagel & Anna Cathrine

I have not researched this family yet beyond establishing Antonius and Anna Cathrine as the parents of your ancestor Margarethe Nagel. I am enclosing the family group as a point of reference. I have approximated Antonius' birth as 1624 and Anna Cathrine's as 1628. However, these dates may change if their death records are located listing their ages.

Hannß Martin Gamer & Anna Barbara

Based on his age at death, Hannß Martin Gamer was born in 1639 at Staffort, the son of Johannes Gamer and Barbara. He married Anna Barbara about 1664, probably at Staffort. She was born in 1637 (according to her age at death), probably at Staffort.

Hannß and Anna are the parents of 8 known children; all born at Stafford. Except for locating the death of the daughter Anna Barbara, born 1684, this family group record is complete.

Recommendations:

1. Search church records for Blankenloch and Stafford in an effort to complete the enclosed family group records.
2. Compile a family group record for Antonius Nagel and Anna Cathrine.
3. Search the records of Rußheim to see if additional children can be identified for Bernhard Körber.
4. Search the records of Blankenloch to see if additional children can be identified for Georg Müller and Barbara.
5. Search the records of Stafford to see if additional children can be identified for Hanß Jost Stober and Anna Catharina Maria Zeiter.

Please examine the enclosed materials and compare them with other records in your possession and advise me if you have any questions regarding the research.

An additional retainer, along with any instructions, will be required to continue the research.
